Families are encouraged to bring non-perishable food items which will be donated to the Westfield Food Pantry. After the hunt, children are welcome to play field games and have their face painted, or share a moment with some of our community's more colorful characters, including Sparky the Fire Dog, Stanley Starfire, and more.

This event represents a return to an in-person celebration for the city's children, after a few years of providing a "drive through" experience. "We had a great turnout for last year's event that offered a new spin on the classic Egg Hunt to fit the unique circumstances, and I am grateful to all the sponsors and volunteers who are helping us return to the traditional format this year." said Mayor McCabe, "We are going all in, rain or shine!"
